- **At 110 degrees, your pet may have just minutes to live!** Your pet will suffer heatstroke, leading to collapse, brain damage and an agonizing death!

**If Your Pet Is Overheated,
Take Emergency Action!**

Immediately, put your pet into cold water or give a cold-water rubdown to lower body temperature.

Take your pet to a veterinarian for a thorough examination.
