Important Provisions:

1. Application deadline – **April 1, 2010**
2. **Set-up and check-in** will take place between **7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.** on **Saturday, May 15**. All vendors are to have vehicles in the designated parking area and return by foot to their booths no later than 9:30 a.m. Booths should be completely set up by the start of the event (10 am) and must remain open until Bark in the Park officially closes at 3 p.m.
3. Vendors will be sheltered under a large tent(s) – Each vendor will be designated a 10'x10' space - individual tents are not available or permitted.
4. The Humane Society of Missouri will provide **one 8 ft. table, 3 chairs, skirting and a sign noting the company/organization name**. All other materials must be provided by the vendor.
5. Please allow no more than 4 people at your booth at one time.
6. **Final event details including information about check-in, parking & booth placement will be sent via e-mail and mail in late-April or early-May 2010.**

The Humane Society of Missouri reserves the right to reject any application, relocate any booth or reject any organization due to size limitations or other factors that prove detrimental to the event. All parties selling merchandise must be listed on the application and are responsible for filing and paying all of their own applicable sales taxes. No weapons of any kind will be permitted at Bark in the Park 2010. Vendors who are found to be in possession of or selling weapons will have their booths shut down and be escorted off the site by security personnel.
